Important Call to Prayer and Action

Last year, The House of Lords successfully agreed a free speech amendment to the Sexual Orientation Regulations. The Government is now trying to remove this protection in the Coroners and Justice Bill (Clause 61), at committee stage in the Lords again. Not only this, this bill covers euthanasia and several peers have added amendments which go some way in relaxing existing laws on assisted suicide. There is a petition in Church today which calls for life and liberty to be protected and it would be fantastic if as many people as possible could sign it. **THIS MUST BE DONE TODAY PLEASE** as it is to be sent to Christian Concern for Our Nation on Monday to be then taken onto 10 Downing Street and also presented to Her Majesty the Queen.
