On Tuesday, Peers voted to reject plans to soften the laws on Euthanasia and on Thursday, they rejected Government plans to remove a free speech protection with regard to sexual orientation. Thank you to everyone who signed the petition and who contacted Peers. **Your prayers and actions made a difference.** Please pray that the Government would now accept the will of The Lords and thousands of Christians, as the Bill passes back to the House of Commons.
