Advertising of Abortion Services – urgent action required

There are now well over 200,000 unborn babies killed annually in UK now - the size of a small city!

A **very significant step** on the way to **even more abortions** in the UK is likely to take place with the broadcast of what Marie Stopes International terms the 'first ever commercial for abortion services to air in Britain' last Monday.

This advert must be recognised for what it is - a deceptive marketing exercise. Abortion is not mentioned in the brief clip yet Marie Stopes in its own press release is presenting it as a commercial for abortion services. This deception must be exposed - for it threatens to be part of a wider strategy to further normalise abortion in our nation.
